COMES NOW Dr. Brian Holmes, MD, Dickinson County Health Officer and does hereby order that all schools located within Dickinson County, Kansas public or private are hereby closed for on-site school attendance until Monday morning at 7:00 a.m. March 30, 2020.

In support of such medical declaration Dickinson County Health Department Officer Dr. Brian Holmes states as follows:

1. Based on the scientific evidence collected concerning COVID-19 the disease meets the definition of severe acute respiratory syndromes.
2. The COVID-19 is a communicable disease in the United States. Therefore as Dickinson County Health Officer I do hereby order all schools within Dickinson County, Kansas to close for regular school attendance and remain closed until 7:00 a.m. on March 30, 2020 or as further ordered.
3. I also recommend but not order that gatherings of more than 100 people in one location be avoided until March 30, 2020 as may be amended by this office.
