

DICKINSON COUNTY TRANSFER STATION

The Transfer Station located at 2363 Jeep Road, Abilene, Ks. is a county owned facility.

Operating hours are Monday – Friday 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, Saturday 9:00 am to 1:00 pm.

The solid waste is transferred to Hamm Quarry at Perry, Ks. There is a charge of \$50.00 per ton with a \$10.00 minimum charge for 500 lbs. or less.

Dead animals less than <u>80 lb.</u> in weight. All animals must be <u>double</u> bagged with heavy weight bags.	Charge
Animal waste that is double bagged with heavy weight bags.	Charge
Tree limbs and brush – 12 in. diameter.	Free 4 th Saturday of each month only.
Grass clippings & leaves	Free

ELECTRONIC WASTE DISPOSAL

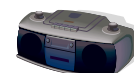
Electronic waste or E-Waste refers to products
