Why can't I just throw them in the trash?

Batteries, especially lithium-ion batteries, consist of highly toxic materials that are often caustic, flammable, and volatile.

This can lead to spontaneous combustion of flammable materials commonly found in trash.

How do I properly dispose of batteries?

Batteries should be kept separate from regular household trash. They can be disposed of safely at our Household Hazardous Waste Facility **free of charge**.
